Description

Two men and one woman stand on the sidewalk in front of the Progress Dry Goods Store in Albuquerque, New Mexico. A banner attached to the awning above the storefront reads "La tienda mas barata en Albuquerque" [The cheapest shop in Albuquerque]. Quilts, men's shirts, and linen handkerchiefs are displayed in the shop windows and hung over the doorway of the store. The top right corner of the plate is broken.
