Description

This image depicts a small utility building in Albuquerque, New Mexico. In the immediate foreground of the image, a small dirt pathway can be seen running next to a ditch. The building itself is made of brown stucco and is shaped like a small cube. Chain link fences, a large truck, and various sized containers can be seen behind the building.
